

TIPRM Privacy Policy Notice of January 2020

The policy: This privacy policy notice is served by The Institute of Pest Risk Management (TIPRM), tiprm.com. This policy explains how we strive to control, process, handle and protect personal information. If you do not agree to the policy, as explained in this document, then please cease viewing and using this website, and also do not submit any personal data.

In this document, these terms are defined as particular meaning:

- "I", "our", "us", or "we" refer to TIPRM.
- "you", "the user" refer to the person(s) using this website.
- "Cookies" mean small files stored on a users computer or device.
- "GDPR" means General Data Protection Act.
- "ICO" means Information Commissioner's Office.
- "PECR" means Privacy & Electronic Communications Regulation.

Key principles of GDPR:

Our privacy policy embodies the following key principles; (a) Lawfulness, fairness and transparency, (b) Purpose limitation, (c) Data minimisation, (d) Accuracy, (e) Storage limitation, (f) Integrity and confidence, (g) Accountability.

We will attempt to handle subject access requests in accordance with the GDPR.

Internet cookies

We use cookies on this website to provide you with a better user experience. We do this by placing a small text file on your device / computer hard drive to track how you use the

website, to record or log whether you have seen particular messages that we display, to keep you logged into the website where applicable, to display relevant adverts or content, referred you to a third party website.

Some cookies are required to enjoy and use the full functionality of this website.

We use a cookie control system which allows you to accept the use of cookies, and control which cookies are saved to your device/computer. These cookies are produced automatically by the software that runs on our server. We are not coding wizards. Some cookies may be saved for specific time periods, where others may remain indefinitely.
